dispossession and forced migration in the middle east remain even today significant

elements of contemporary life in the region dawn chatty s book traces the history of those who as a reconstructed middle east emerged at the beginning of the twentieth century found themselves cut off from their homelands refugees in a new world with borders created out of the ashes of war and the fall of the ottoman empire as an anthropologist the author is particularly sensitive to individual experience and how these experiences have impacted on society as a whole from the political social and environmental perspectives through personal stories and interviews within different communities she shows how some minorities such as the armenian and circassian communities have succeeded in integrating and creating new identities whereas others such as the palestinians and the kurds have been left homeless within impermanent landscapes

the idea of home in law displacement and dispossession explores an important set of legal and policy issues surrounding the concepts of home and homelessness taking a growing area of legal scholarship into the new arena of human rights and international law the collection considers the ideas concerning home both in the sense of the dwelling place as a special type of property and territorial claims to homeland which underpin many contemporary legal problems by examining a range of contexts where people are displaced or dispossessed from their homes the essays focusing on dispossession consider themes ranging from mortgage and rent arrears in the uk to responses to the foreclosure crisis in the usa and from eviction for the purposes of economic development in south africa to the exclusion of asylum seekers from the uk s social housing and welfare provision and within the framework of the european convention on human rights the displacement theme meanwhile examines transnational home issues from the experiences of exiles and refugees in areas of conflict to the impact of the broader context of economic social and cultural rights on attempts to protect housing and home through international law at the heart of each essay the contributors experts from across the fields of law policy and housing rights examine the circumstances in which displacement and dispossession take place and reconsider how law and policy respond to such circumstances with a particular focus on the impact of loss of home for the human person at a time of particular and increasing concern about security of tenure and the role of law and policy in protecting people who are vulnerable to forced eviction the idea of home in law presents a bold opportunity to raise questions about the rights and norms

associated with housing and home and to generate new insights for scholarship and for national and international policy debates concerning displacement and dispossession

traces the history of refugees and migrants within a reconstructed twentieth century middle east

this volume explores the extent to which forced migration has become a feature of life in the middle east and north africa papers are grouped around four related themes displacement repatriation identity in exile and refugee policy providing a significant contribution to this developing highly pertinent area of contemporary research

this sociolegal study focuses on the political legal and institutional problems and dilemmas of regulating land tenure by studying the development of the timorese formal land tenure system this book engages in the larger debate about the role of state systems in addressing and aggravating social problems such as insecurity poverty inequality destruction of nature and cultural and social estrangement land tenure issues in timor leste are complex and deeply shaped by the nation s history taking an insider s perspective based on the author s experience in timorese state administration and through the investigation of five analytical themes political environment lawmaking legal framework institutional framework and social relationships and practices this book studies the development of the timorese formal land tenure system from independence in 2002 to 2018 it shows how political legal and administrative decisions on land administration are made what and who influences them which problems and dilemmas emerge and how the formal system works in practice the result is a portrait of a young nation grappling with the enormous task of creating a land tenure system that can address the needs of its citizens in the wake of centuries of socio political tumult and huge fluctuations in resources the book concludes by highlighting the importance of lawmaking and how abuses of power can be curbed by adequate administrative processes and laws finally it argues that land administration is primarily a political matter the political dimension of technical solutions must be considered if we aim to achieve fairer formal land tenure systems the pertinence of the topics covered the multi disciplinary perspective and the research methodology followed make this book appealing to a variety of readers including international organizations practitioners academics and students engaged in land administration post colonial and conflict issues lawmaking rule of law public administration and issues of access and exclusion
